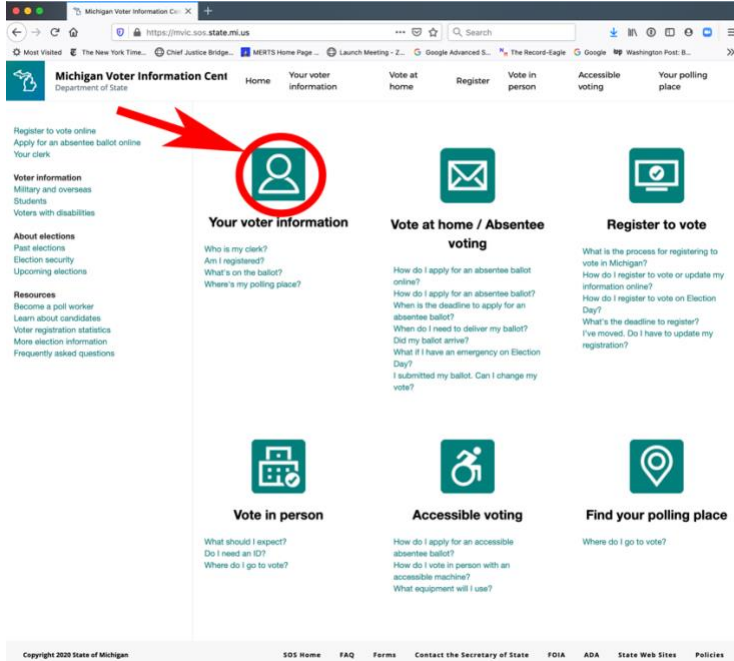


Track your Ballot as easy as 1,2,3 with Pictures

1. Go to mi.gov/vote or <https://mVIC.sos.state.mi.us/> (Both work the same.) Your screen will look as shown below. Click on “Your voter information.”



2. The next screen will ask for identity information. You have several choices. The easiest is usually to search by name and birth date. Fill in and click on “search by name.”
